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Texas 60 x 30 Goals (THECB 2015-2030)

- By 2030, 60% of Texans ages 25-34 will have a certificate or a degree. (**Overarching Goal**)
- By 2030, at least 550,000 students in that year will complete a certificate, associate, bachelor's, or master's from an institution of higher education in Texas. (**Completion**)
- By 2030, all graduates from Texas public institutions of higher education will have completed programs with identified marketable skills. (**Marketable Skills**)
- By 2030, undergraduate student loan debt will not exceed 60 percent of first-year wages for graduates of Texas public institutions. (**Student Debt**)

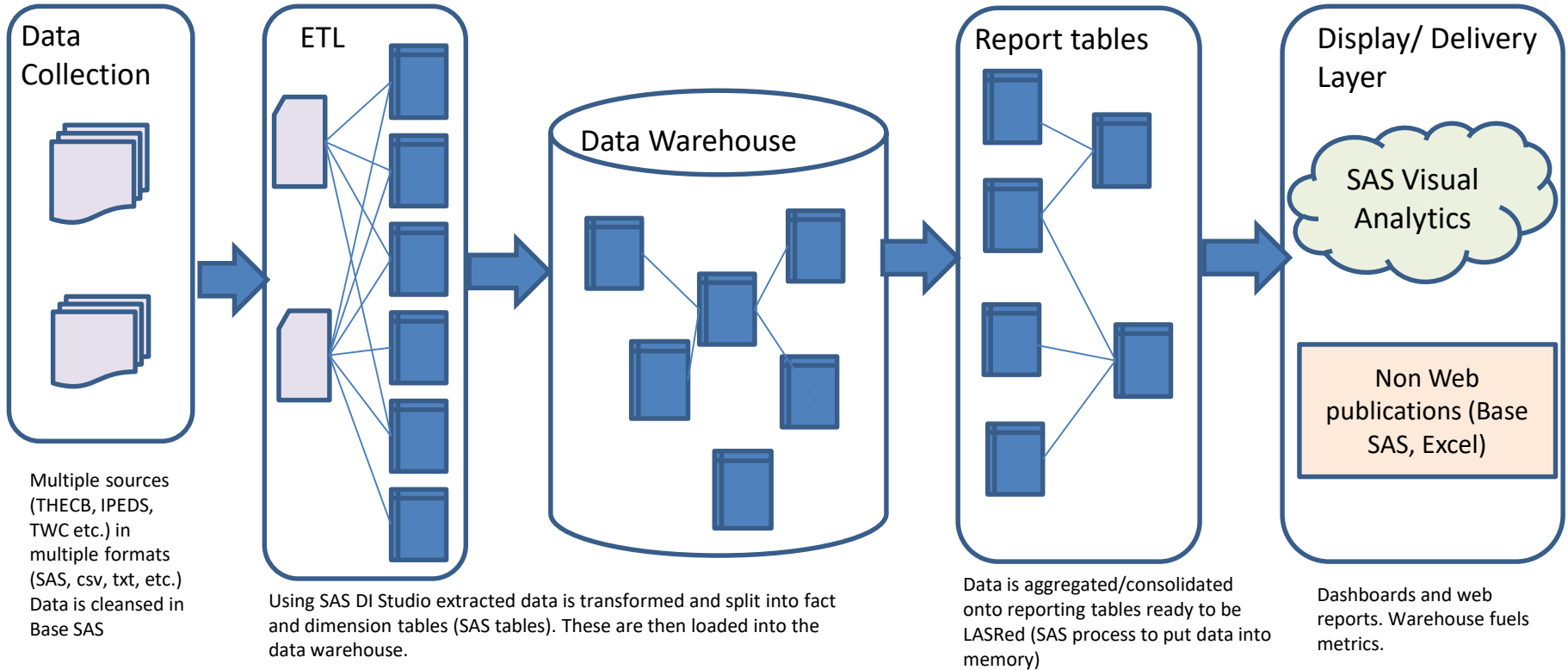

seekUT Helps Students Pursue a Degree

- Program descriptions, basic and specific degree requirements, credit hours needed to earn each degree, and percentage of graduates continuing their education
- Data available for graduate and professional students
- Value of a degree, including ROI for liberal arts degrees (national)
- Importance of completion vs. non-completion



seekUT Enables Better Financial Planning

- Earnings of UT graduates based on program – 1, 5, and 10 years after graduation
- A realistic look at average student loan debt by program, as well as monthly loan payment
- Debt-to-income ratio – understand monthly earnings alongside estimated monthly student loan payment
- Percentage of students who borrowed



seekUT Enables Better Career Planning

- Projected job growth – identify job openings by occupation (2012-2022)
- Top industries by program and degree level
- What industries are graduates working in? (by major)
- How salaries compare in different states?
- Career opportunities available to UT graduates in-state and nationally
 - What are the degree requirements?
- Graduate school information
- Better salary negotiations and benchmarking through data
