

























 Centralized office created in August of 2020 to engage institutional and system leaders to develop, implement, and evaluate outcomes-based strategies that address inequities in all areas.





The System Enrolls a Disproportionate Number of URM Students



Six-year Graduation Rates of non-URM and URM First-time, Full-time, Bachelor's Degree-seeking Studentsby Comparator Universities



Conferred Degrees for Underrepresented Minority Students with Comparators


Pennsylvania's State System of Higher Education Percentage of Total Degrees Conferred for Underrepresented Minorities, by Comparator Universities




Version 1

- Aggregate data files also available

Version 2 of dashboard includes specific breakout for personnel

- All universities and system level
- Additional filter for race/ethnicity and sex
- Snapshot by bargaining unit for 10 years of data
- Trend data available for all bargaining and sub units
- Disaggregation of broad categories available
- Aggregate data files also available
- Future updates include an ongoing conversation about career trajectories including time/success for tenure
