






#### Where do Iowa Baccalaureate Degree Recipients Work One Year after Graduation?


#### Where do Iowa Baccalaureate Degree Recipients Work 5 Years after Graduation?

#### Where do Iowa Baccalaureate Degree Recipients Work 10 Years after Graduation?



Requires Iowa public universities to show the following by university, academic major and graduating class:

- Income
- Student debt
- Ratio of debt to income
- Percent who earn a masters or doctoral degree
